Draft EIS now available; share your feedback by Nov. 2, 2026

We want your input!

Sound Transit and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have published the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Everett Link Extension project. Your feedback directly shapes the future of the regional transit system. The FTA and Sound Transit encourage Tribes, agencies, and the public to comment on the alternatives, environmental findings, and potential mitigation measures detailed in the Draft EIS. After the comment period, the Board will identify, confirm, or modify the preferred alternative based on information in the Draft EIS and input from Tribes, agencies, and the public.

What is an EIS?

An EIS explores how the different project alternatives could affect the physical, natural, and human environment. It covers topics such as noise, traffic, wetlands, land use, property acquisitions and displacements, and more. It also explains how potential impacts would be reduced where feasible. Reviewing the Draft EIS can help you understand how different station, route, and Operations and Maintenance Facility (OMF) North alternatives could affect the issues that matter most to you.
